# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT DEVICES ARE NEEDED TO VOTE?

The system can be used on phones, laptops, iPads and/or tablets. It requires the ability to connect to the internet or Wi-Fi as it is completely online.

### ARE CHARGING POINTS AVAILABLE AT THE SESSION HALLS?

Ideally, have all your devices fully charged before you get to the venue as while there are some charging points it may not be sufficient for over 120 delegates attending the conference. The charging points will be found in the networking spaces.

### WHO WILL BE THE FLAG BEARERS?

During the Opening Ceremony on 19 August, each MO will be asked to nominate a representative to carry their national flag. All flag bearers will receive a briefing message in advance of the Opening to enable them to prepare for this role.

### WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE FOR THE INTERNATIONAL NIGHT AND INDIA NIGHT?

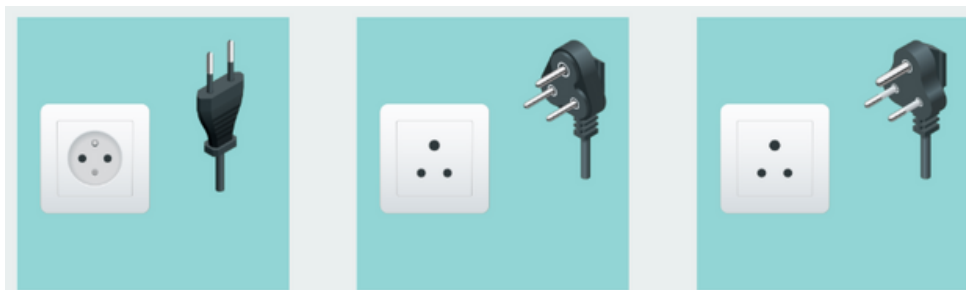
The dress code for International Night and India Night is a national dress.

### WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE FOR THE GALA DINNER?

For the Gala Dinner, a national dress or any formal dress can be worn. Since, it's FAPW's Silver Anniversary, we encourage everyone to dress with something silver.

### WHAT IS THE PLUG AND OUTLET TYPE IN INDIA?

India has 3 associated plug types: type C, type D, and type M. Type C has two round parallel pins. Type D has three round pins. Type M has three round pins in a triangle shape, where the top one is longer and thicker. The standard voltage in India is 230V at a frequency of 50Hz. If the plug shape in India is different to your home country you might need to get a travel adapter.

### **WHAT IS THE CURRENCY IN INDIA?**

The currency in India is the Indian Rupee (symbol: ₹, code: INR). There are ATMs at the Delhi airport where you may get cash on arrival. There are no ATMs at the Leela Convention Hotel but you may withdraw cash in nearby shopping malls.

### **WHAT IS THE WEATHER IN AUGUST IN INDIA?**

August in Delhi is characterised by receding monsoon showers and temperatures ranging between approximately 25.8C to 32.3C. Delhi weather in August experiences nearly 13 hours of sunlight daily, interspersed with occasional rainfall. The humidity levels remain high, and the warm breeze offers a soothing respite.

### **WHAT IS THE COUNTRY CODE IN INDIA?**

India's country code is +91.

### **WHAT IS THE EMERGENCY NUMBER IN INDIA?**

India's emergency number is 112.

### **WHAT IS THE TIME ZONE IN INDIA?**

India uses only one time zone (even though it spans two geographical time zones) across the whole nation and all its territories, called Indian Standard Time (IST), which equates to UTC+05:30.

### **IS WI-FI AVAILABLE AT THE VENUE?**

Wi-Fi is available at the hotel, but you may also purchase a SIM card at the airport for data.
