1.	Location	Northern India, bordered by Bihar, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, and Nepal.
2.	Capital	Lucknow
3.	Largest City	Kanpur
4.	Area	Approximately 240,928 sq km (4th largest state in India by area)
5.	Population	Approximately 241 million (most populous Indian state, as per Census 2011)
6.	Language	Hindi (official), Urdu widely spoken
7.	Economy	Predominantly agricultural, major industries include textiles, sugar, IT, handicrafts, and leather goods.
8.	Agriculture	Major crops include wheat, rice, sugarcane, potatoes, pulses, mangoes, and vegetables.
9.	Historical Significance	Home to ancient cities such as Varanasi, Ayodhya, Prayagraj, Mathura, and historical landmarks like Taj Mahal, Fatehpur Sikri, and Sarnath.
10.	Culture & Festivals	Rich cultural heritage with popular festivals like Diwali, Holi, Eid, Kumbh Mela, and Ram Navami.
11.	Tourism	Prominent tourist destinations include the Agra, Varanasi, Sarnath, Ayodhya, Prayagraj, Lucknow and wildlife sanctuaries like Dudhwa National Park.
12.	Administration	Divided into 75 districts, governed through a bicameral legislature, with a Chief Minister as head of government.

Eligibility Criteria for Participation	<p>Participation in the Jamboree is open to Scouts, Guides, Rovers, and Rangers who meet the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age Group: 12 to 18 years • Qualification: Must have completed at least the Dwitiya Sopan Badge (for Scouts/Guides) and Nipun Badge (for Rovers/Rangers) <p>Participation will be permitted at a ratio of 8:1, i.e., eight Scouts/Guides accompanied by one Unit Leader.</p>
Transportation Facilities	The host State Association will facilitate the participant to transport from Railway Station/Bus Station and Back.

TOURISM AND HERITAGE IN LUCKNOW

AYODHYA



The Ayodhya Ram Mandir in Uttar Pradesh is a grand Hindu temple built at the birthplace of Lord Rama, on the historic Ram Janmabhoomi site. After a decades-long legal and religious dispute, the Supreme Court in 2019 cleared the way for its construction. The foundation was laid by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on August 5, 2020, and the temple was consecrated on January 22, 2024. Built in the traditional Nagara style using pink sandstone and marble, the temple spans 380x250 feet with intricately carved pillars and shrines. It stands as a symbol of faith, heritage, and national unity, attracting lakhs of devotees and transforming Ayodhya into a major spiritual and tourism hub.

As one of the gracefully simple structures, Bara Imambara has several round domes. Made in 1784, Nawab Asaf-ud-Daula created an architectural baldachin within the large structure. There's the somehow large prayer hall positioned toward the Qibla, several spacious courtyards, and the ever-popular and interesting 'Bhul Bhulaiya' which is a breathtaking network of skinny passages. This was made without a single nail or any wood being employed throughout the whole erection.

BARA IMAMBARA

This beautifully protruding arch surrounded by Mughal ornamental tiles is one of the best structures that cannot be ignored by many as it symbolizes a lot of the history of the Mughal culture in Lucknow. It was created by Nawab Asaf-ud-Daula in the year 1784. This structure is 60 ft high and is designed in the Awadhi architectural fashion with a likeness to the gates of Istanbul. It makes an ideal place for, what can be called, pictures that will last a lifetime.

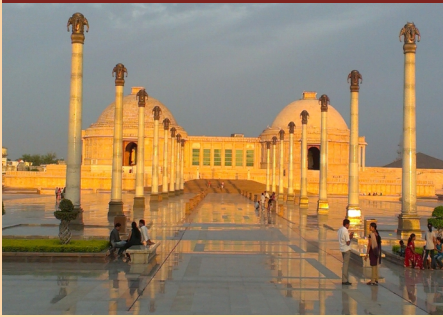

BR AMBEDKAR PARK



The Dr. B. R. Ambedkar Park is located in Gomti Nagar and is a great structure that commemorates the life and work of Dr. B. R. Ambedkar alongside other patrons of social reform. This large park built with red sandstone contains beautiful sculptures, manicured lawns, and a serene atmosphere. It's a wonderful spot ideal for evening strolls or family time.

The Lucknow residency is a very significant place that had great significance during the period of the First War of Independence, in the year 1857. This place was constructed during the period of British colonization, and today, it stands as a peaceful mess with its gardens around it and a museum containing interesting materials and stories about the history of this particular area. This is surely quite an enchanting site for those who are interested in history.
