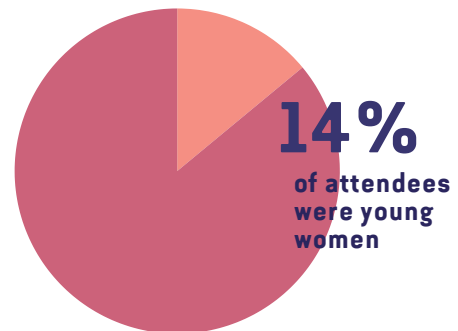
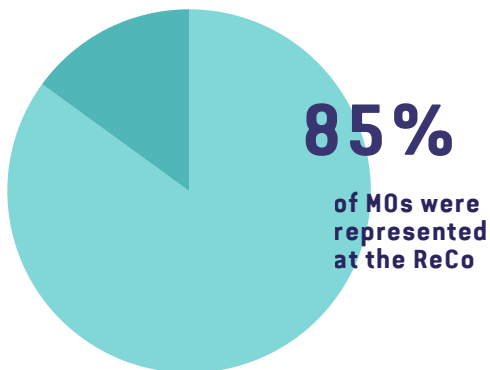
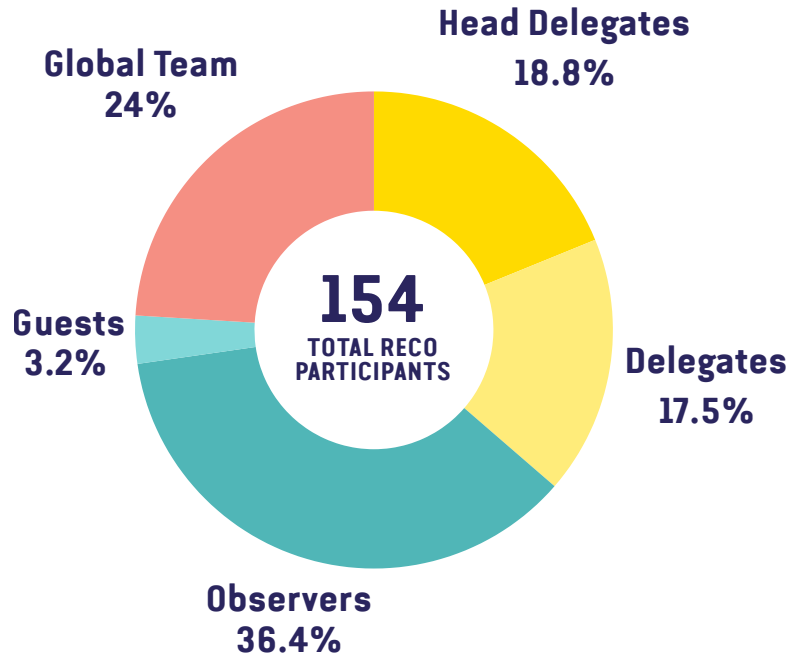
A total of 154 Conference participants took part in the event, representing 29 MOs.

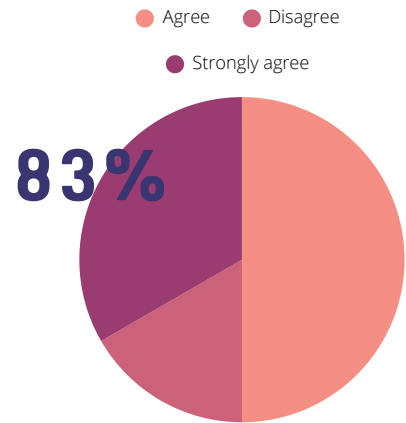

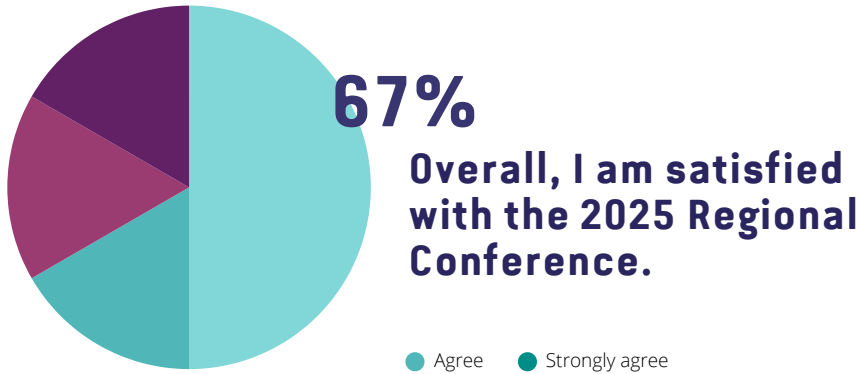

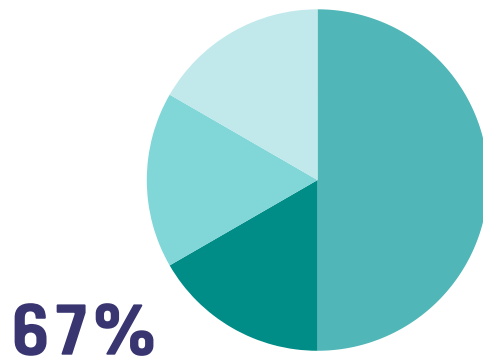
I felt connected to the wider Movement of Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting.



Legend: Agree (light teal), Strongly agree (dark teal), strongly disagree (dark purple), Disagree (medium purple)

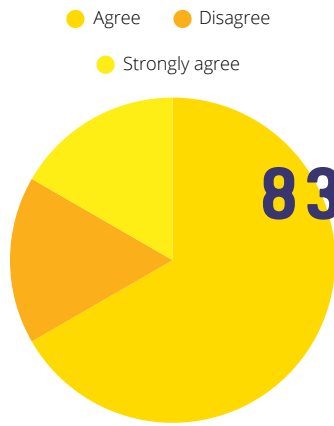

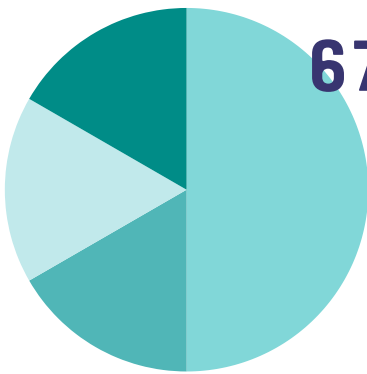
I am leaving the Regional Conference with greater knowledge of the Region.

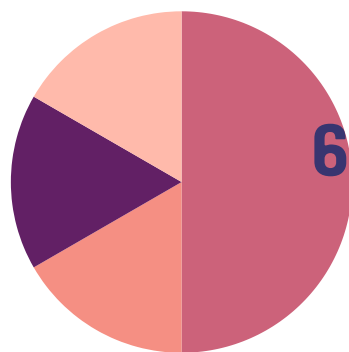
83% of the respondents said that the Regional Conference programme was relevant to them and their delegations.

- Disagree (dark teal)



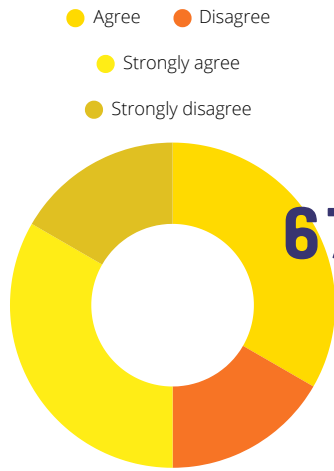
67% of the respondents said that there were enough spaces and sessions that enabled productive discussion and interaction.

- Strongly disagree (light red)

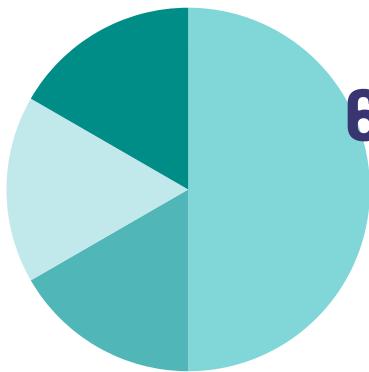


67% of the respondents said that the nominations and election process for members of the Regional Committee was clear, transparent, and smooth.

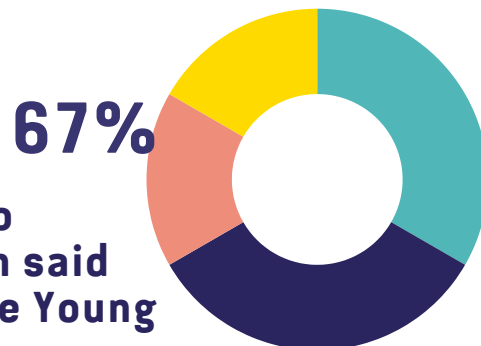
What Worked Well
