

Joint Work Working Group

We're looking for a group of 2 team members and 1 Co-lead volunteer from WAGGGS MOs.

WAGGGS and WOSM (World Organisation of the Scout Movement) work closely together in the Europe Region. The work of the group will contribute to the further development of joint work and help achieve the objectives of the Joint Action Plan. At the Europe Regional Conference in 2025, MOs asked for a review Azimuth and other exchange fora. We are seeking your help with this.

What you will do:

- Form a working group with 2 team members and 1 Co-lead volunteer from WOSM.
- Carry out consultations with MOs/NSOs to refine the content of the Joint Work Plan.
- Conduct a concept review of the the IC Forum.
- Review and assess existing joint consultation and exchange mechanisms (Azimuth). Explore potential models for the sustainability or further development of joint platforms.
- Consult on future learning and exchange opportunities with MOs/NSOs.

Desired skills/previous experience in:

- Have experience in reviewing concepts and supporting or guiding consultation processes,
- Possess a basic understanding of WOSM and WAGGGS, including structures and ways of working at regional level.

MO Networking Support Working Group

We are looking for a group of 6 team members and 2 Lead Volunteers

Strong and connected Member Organisations (MOs) are at the heart of the WAGGGS Europe Region.

The Working Group strengthens collaboration and exchange between MO representatives through supporting structured and purposeful networking.

The working group focuses on creating **connection-focused**, GAL-aligned spaces where MOs can share priorities, needs and be connected.

What you will do:

- Provide technical and logistic support, to enable meaningful high-quality, connection and sharing between Member Organisations. A strong focus will be on International Commissioner gatherings. You will also provide support for other areas of work serving regional priorities, delivered by regional or global working groups.
- Facilitate asynchronous and synchronous connection (both live and online sessions and ongoing connection between meetings)
- Keep updated with tools that can foster connection and effective online engagement

Desired skills / experience:

- Experience within a Member Organisation or in regional collaboration is beneficial but not required
- Interest or experience in facilitating online meetings, connection spaces, or group processes
- Experience with online collaboration and meeting tools as Teams, Zoom, Miro-board, campfire (Open Social) are highly appreciated
- Strong listening skills and ability to support constructive discussion



Compass Camp Support Volunteers

We are looking for 2 volunteers.

Compass Camp is a Europe Region event that brings together girls and young women from across Member Organisations (MOs) to connect, learn, and grow through shared experiences rooted in Guiding values. The Compass Camp Support Volunteers are starting the planning process of the camp at a regional level.

This role focuses on **preparation and starting the planning process**, doing a feasibility study, working closely with the Europe Region Committee and relevant staff. It does not involve programme content delivery.

What you will do:

- Contribute to the preparatory phase of planning, including support and coordination on a call for a host MO, designing timelines and tracking tasks.
- Act as a coordination link between the Europe Region Committee, staff, and the host MO
- Support logistical preparation and communication, including participant-related information
- Contribute to reflection and learning after the event to inform future regional events

Desired skills / experience

- Interest or experience in event planning, coordination, or logistics. Previous experience with regional events is beneficial but not required
- Experience working with volunteers or in regional / international contexts
- Organisational skills and ability to work with shared timelines
- Motivation to contribute to **safe, inclusive, and empowering spaces** for girls and young women
