

**Call for International Facilitation Training Programme – Facilitators & Volunteers
(Q3/Q4 Cohort, 2026)**

LEAD FACILITATOR (2 ROLES)

This role will oversee the team in delivering the Q3/Q4 2026 online cohorts and lead organisation of facilitators for the sessions. They will also oversee the participants' learning journey and record completion of sessions and tasks for participants.

Preferred Skills and Experience:

Language: Fluency (native speaker or equivalent) in English is required. While not required, it is great if one lead is bilingual in English and French.

Technology: A stable Internet connection (particularly for planning calls and session delivery), knowledge of Miro and Campfire (or willingness to learn).

Personal abilities: Have strong non-formal facilitation skills, including experience facilitating within WAGGGS event. This role is entirely online so you'll need to work well in virtually and be able to meet deadlines during the cohort.

What will we expect from you?

You must be an existing member of the WAGGGS volunteer pool and an accredited WAGGGS facilitator, and able to commit to volunteering for the duration of the cohort. You'll need to manage the team of facilitators and oversee the learning journey of participants. We expect you to perform your volunteer role to the best of your ability and act professionally when representing WAGGGS.

What will you get in return?

You'll get to inspire the next generation of WAGGGS facilitators from across the world, whilst working with a team of incredible women who share your passion for learning and development. You'll get to build your knowledge of WAGGGS facilitation.

Time Commitment: One role would begin in late June 2026 and run until the end of November 2026 and the other begins at the start of July until the end of December 2026.
